Outreach Team Collecting Hygiene Kits

Church World Service (CWS) is one of the organizations that responds to natural and human disasters around the world, around the year. We like to help stock their response supplies. When floods contaminate the water and everything you own is contaminated, the gift of a washcloth, soap and a toothbrush is priceless. We help CWS collect those kinds of things together into a "Hygiene Kit" which can be stored, then instantly shipped where needed.

Our goal is to be able to put together 100 kits on "Service Sunday" September 21st. We will be collecting the supplies the month of August. Sign-up sheets will be on the bulletin board the month of August to make sure we gather enough of each item on the list.



The CWS Hygiene Kit now includes travel-sized shampoo, deodorant, lotion, and toothpaste, making it more practical for people on the move or in temporary shelters. These updates ensure the kits meet immediate needs with greater care and relevance.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1-gallon resealable plastic bag Washcloth Fingernail or toenail clipper (packaging removed) Toothbrush (in original packing) Bath-size bar of soap (in original packaging) Travel-size deodorant (3.4 oz. or less, non-aerosol) Travel-size lotion (3.4 oz. or less, fragrance-free, NEW only) Travel-size shampoo (3.4 oz. or less, NEW only) Travel-size toothpaste (3.4 oz. or less, expiration date of 1 year) Sturdy wide-tooth comb (6" minimum teeth, packaging removed)

Stewardship is an ongoing issue for the Church, one that we discuss either too much, during the weekly invitation to giving, or too little, by only occasionally running a fall stewardship campaign. Some members of the congregation want to hear less, and others want to hear more. Pastor Mike succeeds in doing what most of us want on the issue,

most of the time. His invitation to giving is always founded in the Scripture, usually in the words of Christ.

Our response by giving is an individual or a family reaction to the nudge we feel during our times when we hear the call to give. Is the nudge one that invites us to mission work, providing help to our neighbors in the community or around the world? Is the nudge a desire to care for our pastor and staff? Is the nudge an obligation to maintain and improve the church property, and keep the lights and air conditioning on?

As chair of the stewardship team, I pledge that we will continue this discussion later this year. I invite us all to spend a few moments each time we hear the invitation for giving to see if there is a nudge to do more. After all we are supporting the Lord's work, whatever our response is to His invitation.


